The ideal scenario is for teams to arrive at a consensus decision where everyone's opinion is heard. However, that doesn't always happen naturally: assertive people tend to get the most attention. Less forthright team members can often feel intimidated and don't always speak up, particularly when their ideas are different from the popular view.

Specifically, students learn about the decision-making process and then apply that knowledge to scenarios. To accomplish this, the activity is broken into two parts. First is the "poker chip activity," in which you'll highlight the importance of having as much information as possible prior to making a decision.

## **5 Best Decision Making Activities for Middle School**

Students will use the five-step (ABCDE) model of the decision-making process to determine the solutions and consequences of four example scenarios. Follow the ABCDE model: Assess the problem, Brainstorm alternative solutions, Consider the consequences of each, Decide and act, Evaluate the consequences.

Scenario planning for strategic decision-making A core method in strategic foresight is scenario planning or "rehearsing for the future." Scenarios are stories about possibilities, hypothetical sequences of events leading to plausible situations.

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Examples of making bad business decisions. Examples aren't hard to find: Coca Cola's roll out of "New Coke" , the disastrous BP oil spill in the Gulf, Microsoft's refusal to believe the Internet was a threat (first with Netscape , then later with Google), GM's thirty year focus on lobbying and marketing instead of innovation and customer service, etc.
